What's Included in the Program?

- 1. A hands-on Internship
- 2. A 3 credit-hour college course credit
- 3. Start-up business planning
- 4. Training on marketing through ATTRA/NCAT; and
- 5. Pairing with an appropriate veteran agriculture mentor through the KY AgVets network.

Who can Apply?

Transitioning soldiers within the last 180 days of service. Soldiers must remain on active duty for the duration of the internship.

Time and Financial Commitment:

The AgVets internship program will be an eight-week internship hosted by a local agribusiness or farm. All course fees will be paid through the AgVets grant and participants will get to choose from agribusinesses as well as individual producers. Applicants will receive hands-on experience and are required to submit a final summary of their internship to receive full credit for the class. The internship will be offered three times a year with one held in the spring, one during the summer, and one in the fall.
